# Chair's Report

*September, 2017*

It continues to be an exciting time to live in the New Richmond area. The opening of the St. Croix River Bridge may be the most visible sign of change, but it is just one of many indicators. The Foundation Board is proud of the role it continues to play in the positive changes happening in this community.

The Board recognizes the importance of active and passive recreation in maintaining our quality of life. That is why we've entered into the New Richmond Recreation Partnership with the City, the School District and The Centre. Together we are preparing and executing a plan for meeting the community's current and long-term recreation and lifestyle needs. The Pathways Committee has completed Phase 1 of the Willow River Water Trail, removing debris and log jams between the Mill Pond Dam and Boardman. Work has begun on clearing obstructions on the eastern portion of the river. Soon the dam will be the only impediment to paddling from the 160th Street Bridge to Boardman! The 140th Street Trail over Paperjack Creek nears completion. With help from the Foundation, the New Richmond School Farm has moved from planning to operations. Our Leadership Trust Initiative continues to graduate leaders focused on insuring a positive future for our community.

Despite these successes and the generally positive outlook for our future, challenges remain. We continue to have significant unmet hunger and shelter needs. The scourge of drug abuse, including opioids, methamphetamine and heroin, tears at the fabric of the community. In a community with one of the best school systems in the state, illiteracy remains a concern. Addressing these challenges calls for motivated volunteers and for money. While we have been fortunate to have access to each, we recognize the demands on our volunteer board make it difficult to meet all of the community's needs. The Board determined it was necessary to add a paid staff member to assist with our projects and fundraising.

We are pleased to introduce our new part-time Executive Director, Margret Swanson. Margret brings over three decades of experience in non-profit management and fundraising, as well as a deep commitment to making positive change at a community level. You can read a full biography elsewhere in this Annual Report. Better yet, take a few moments to talk to Margret in person. You will see why she was the unanimous choice from among many qualified candidates. We also remain affiliated with the St. Croix Valley Foundation. SCVF continues to provide us with the administrative support necessary to meet our legal, tax, accounting and non-profit requirements, and has been a wonderful steward of our money, with a 12.7% return on investment this year.

The Foundation could not do what it does without the generosity of our donors. Through donor assistance, we have been able to grant more money into the community than at any time in our history. This is a testament to people like you who care about this community. Thank you for your past and future support of the New Richmond Area Community Foundation.

# Leadership Trust Initiative

Citizenship requires an individual to be engaged in and with his/her community. The Leadership Trust Initiative (LTI) was designed to produce leaders with a deeper awareness of themselves, their community, and the larger world around them. LTI is a nine month course that encourages participants to discover and nurture their unique individual strengths and abilities, thus expanding their leadership capabilities. The program further helps individuals better understand the role of a leader as one who must establish trust and retain the same trust by their actions and involvement in society. LTI also teaches the understanding that a “leader” is not always the person in charge, but a person who understands how to navigate day-to-day in an ever changing world. LTI is about helping citizens identify, fulfill, and sustain their capacity as leaders and contribute to our community’s sustainability and self-determination.
